On board air pressure regulator controller works inconsistently does kilby have a new controller or do I just change the points?

If I file them from time to time it seems to help.

new kilby air filter do you have new air filters?

should I be changing oil? How and when?

any other maintenance or service items?

It sounds like you're talking about the pressure switch. A pressure regulator is a different item. Anyhow, filing the contacts is perfectly fine. Do it all you want. You should also have a second set of contacts in that PS. Just move the wires over to that set.

We do have the FS-07-050 Intake filters but the element is washable. If you have mine, try cleaning it.

Oil changes aren't really necessary since the compressor pumps the oil out pretty fast anyhow. If you feel the need to change the oil, go ahead. Otherwise, it'll last many hours with the same oil. If you burned the oil, that's another story. There are no other maintenance items to deal with except for draining the oil out of the tank once in awhile.
