Only half the camp sites at Crab Flats can be reserved the remainder are on a first come first serve basis (there are about 10 sites still open.)

**Meeting Location:** We will have 2 meet locations. One at Crab Flats campground for those camping. The second is Rocky's roadhouse in Running Springs for members driving up for the day on Saturday July 14.

**Meeting Time:** 8:30 am, in Running Springs plan is to leave for the trail at 9:00 am

This trip, besides the fun of camping together, we will be modifying the bypass around the waterfall (the one by the tree) easier to navigate. We will be doing some heavy lifting, moving and breaking rocks as well as relocating large amounts of dirt and dealing with some trees. Bring your jack hammers, generators, spikes, rock picks, shovels, sledge hammers, dynamite (just kidding), or anything you may think will assist us. As well as less strenuous jobs, we will need help with lookouts to slow traffic and keep communications running for trail safety.

Remember, the more volunteers we have the better.....The USFS wants to show the number of people volunteering, they are not interested if they do anything.

Note: Only those included on our club roster submitted to the San Bernardino National Forest Adopt-a-trail program may participate in Adopt-a-trail activities. Therefore, it is imperative that you RSVP. Email or call Rick or Ray.

**Special Equipment Required:** The trail is rated as Black Diamond, 'Most Difficult'. The two waterfalls define this rating. It is moderate otherwise. Recommend 33-inch tires, at least one locker and skid plates.

**Special Adopt-A-Trail Equipment Required:** The USFS requires closed toe shoes / boots, long pants, long sleeved shirts, gloves, eye protection

**Reminder to Bring:** Camera, Chair, Lunch, Water, etc.

**Lunch:** We will stop for lunch along the trail.
