Special Equipment	Sway bar disconnects, high ground clearance with front and rear lockers, 35 inch tires at a minimum. Tire and Body damage is always a possibility. A good spare is required. A working winch is also required.	
Trail Description	<b>3N69</b> Gold Mountain is Rated by the US Department of Forestry as a <b>BLACK Diamond (Most Difficult)</b> trail. It is a very popular trail in the Big Bear Mountain Area and also holds a Jeep Badge of Honor designation from Jeep USA. We will air down at the trailhead. We will ascend up the trail and enjoy spectacular views of the Baldwin Lake and the city of Big Bear. This Trail has some challenging Rocky sections, a rock garden, and steep grades.
