<b>Special Equipment</b>	Sway Bar disconnects, High Ground clearance 33" tire minimum and at least 1 locker. Skid plates and rocker guards are needed on this trail. A good spare tire. Tire and Body damage always possible		
<b>Trail Description</b>	3N93 Holcomb Creek is a Black Diamond (Most Difficult) trail in the Big Bear area of the San Bernardino National Forest. It's approximately 5.5 miles of rock gardens and off-camber, tippy climbs with a few water crossings of Holcomb Creek. Wet tires add an additional challenge to this trail.
