

John Bull Night Run Announcement

Meeting Location: Big Bear Discovery Center: 40971 North Shore Drive/Hwy 38, Fawnskin, CA 92333

Difficulty Rating: Black Diamond, 'Most Difficult'.

Trail Description: If you have never been on John Bull I suggest you wait and do it during the day before trying to tackle it at night. Your vehicle will appreciate it....

Equipment required: Minimum of 35" tires for long wheel base and 33" tires for short wheel base. Rear locker and either a winch or front locker. Rock lights are suggested. I also suggest a good headlight or flashlight.

Permits Required: You'll need an Adventure Pass they are available at ranger stations, Big 5, sporting goods shops, and at most gas stations in the national forest.

Reminder to Bring: Bring extra water, snacks, basic tools, shovel, and extra weather appropriate clothing.

Communications: CB Channel 4. HAM channel 146.580 MHz (DD1)

Weather: It should be around 60 degrees when we start and could drop down to about 45 by the time we finish. Thunderstorms are always a possibility in the mountains.

NOTE: I suggest you be well rested and/or have plans to spend the night up in Big Bear. I have absolutely no clue how many people are going to show up or how long it will take to complete the run but I do know a good time will be had so please plan accordingly.
