Reminder /Weather	BEWARE of RATTLESNAKES, Bring lunch and extra water, chairs, basic tools, Flashlight, shovel, camera, extra weather appropriate clothing, etc. The weather changes quickly, please be prepared.		
Cautions:	Temperatures can have an extreme variation between the desert and mountain elevations.		
Trail Rating:	The trail is a 1-2. There is an optional side trail (heartbreak ridge), a 3-4, that the group or a portion of the group may take. This would be optional for individual vehicles.		
Meeting Location:	Meet in the parking lot next to (West Side) of Pappy & Harriet's in Pioneertown. Pioneertown is 4 miles from Yucca Valley. Take I10 towards Palm Springs and take exit 117 to CA-62 North to Yucca Valley. In Yucca Valley make a left (West) on Pioneertown Road. There are gas stations and restaurants/fast food places in Yucca Valley		
Meeting Time:	Be at the location by 9:00 am. We will leave on the trail at 9:30am.		
Trailhead Coordinates:	(Meeting Location) GPS (DMS) 34°09'23.2"N 116°29'38.9"W		
Special Equipment	Swaybar disconnects high ground clearance with limited slip or lockers, 31 inch tires are always a plus. Tire and Body damage is always a possibility. A good spare is required.		
Trail Description	The trail goes from near Pioneertown to Onyx summit exiting on to CA-38. The total distance is about 32 miles. We will drive 6 miles from Pioneertown to Rimrock/ Burns Canyon trailhead (2N02) where we will air down. The trail goes through some desert terrain and then into the Canyon. While in the Canyon the elevation will increase from about 4000 feet to 8000 feet within 10 miles. The remainder is travelling through the national forest. The last 6 miles will be on (2N01). Turning right on CA-38 takes you to Big Bear. The Village is 20 miles away. Turning left on CA-38 will take you off the mountain and into the city Redlands where you can get on the I10 freeway. (LUNCH) – We will stop for lunch somewhere around the midway point (around 12pm).
