

Run Announcement

Bishop: Coyote Flats/Silver Canyon

Run Date: August 9, 2025

Trail Leader: Ray Kleinhuizen, trail leader is camping in the mountains above Bishop (contact trail leader for more information)

Trail Description: Coyote Flats is a high plateau, 10K elevation above Bishop in the Sierra Nevada Mtn. The trail has great views of Bishop, and the White mountains to the east. The first part of the trail is steep and near the top there is a short moderate section as the trail passes Sugarloaf peak. We have had trouble in this section on other runs. The secret here is stay away from the soft downhill side of the trail or you will get a cow bell. Once past the moderate section we continue through Coyote Flats. We finish on Coyote Flats Rd. just outside of Bishop.

We will drive through the town of Bishop stopping for gas and other supplies.

We continue the run to Silver Canyon that goes straight up the west side of the White Mountains. If there's been enough rain, the beginning of the trail will have several water crossings. The trail has steep switchbacks up the Canyon and tops out at 10,000 ft. elevation with great views of the Sierra Nevada Mountains to the west.

Difficulty: Moderate,

Special Equipment Required: Recommend 35 inch tires, a least one locker, skid plates and good ground clearance. This trail is not suitable for long wheelbase or stock vehicles.

Reminder to Bring: Chair, Lunch, Water, camera, etc.

Lunch: We will stop along the trail for lunch
