37" tires and lockers front and rear required. This has some very difficult areas. There are no auto parts nearby. Crawl under your jeep and triple check every nut and bolt. If you are concerned, take spare parts i.e. pitman arm, axle shafts, brake hoses, anything that you think might break.

For current conditions call the High Sierra Ranger District at (559) 855-5355.

Shaver Lake drop off truck & trailer, gas up, stock up with last minute provisions. I am suggesting we divide up dinners, rather than everyone cooking every night.

There is great trout fishing at Rock Creek Meadow, a 2 mile walk one way. They bite anything shiny including hooks.

Dusy Ershim winds through the Dinkey Lakes Wilderness and The John Muir Wilderness. The Dinkey Lakes Wilderness lies southeast of Huntington Lake, northwest of Courtright Reservoir. Most of it is above 8,000 feet. Sixteen lakes are clustered in the west-central region of the wilderness. The John Muir Wilderness covers 584,000 acres in the Sierra and Inyo national forests. Elevations range from 4,000 feet to 14,496 feet at Mt. Whitney, and many peaks are above 13,000 feet.
