Trail Description: The Blair Valley trail is a cultural preserve and archeological area that contains pictographs, morteros, and Indian ruins of the 1930s. There are short, easy hikes to see the features. The trail includes soft possible sand in the washes but most of the trail is hard packed. Timeline should take approximately 4 hours.

The Slot and Butte Pass Road contains several slot canyons through the Anza Borrego State Park. Great hiking opportunities based on the availability of time. The trail includes wide washes and soft sand with one hill considered steep. Timeline should take approximately 1 hour on the trail with whatever time is needed to travel to the start of the trail.

Always bring plenty of water, dress warm and be ready for all conditions. Both days are subject to cancellation due to the unpredictable conditions of mother nature.

Difficulty: Easy rating for Blair Valley Cultural Preserve and Moderate rating for the Slot and Butte Pass road.

Special Equipment Required: Any damage is always possible but conditions are mostly light 4 Wheel Drive. As always with Dirt Devil Runs, low transfer case and 4WD is required. No skid plates or positraction/lockers necessary but always good to have on vehicles.
