Meet Time: 9:00 – Be fueled, fed and caffeinated. We will travel as a group to the trailhead which is approximately 8 miles down the paved highway.

Meet Place: We will meet in the triangular-shaped parking lot across the street from the Fawnskin Fire Station. The address is 39188 Rim of the World Dr, Fawnskin, CA 92333

Communications: Dirt Devil Prime: 145.585 – Alternate Dirt Devil 1 (146.580)

Trail Description: Gold Mountain is a 4.5-mile Jeep Badge of Honor Trail. It has a gate keeper just off the main highway. The rocks that make up the gate keeper are cemented in place, so it is not too much of a deterrent. Along the trail there are a few waterfalls that keep things interesting (especially if wet or covered in mud). There are also a few obstacles with alternative lines that can make it easier or more challenging.

Difficulty: Moderate but depending on weather, there can be some more challenging spots

Special Equipment Required:

- Front and rear recovery points
- At least one locker (two is better)
- 33” tires and an appropriate lift on a short wheelbase vehicle and 35’s and an appropriate lift on a longer wheelbase vehicle.
- Rock sliders, skid plates or armor will not eliminate the possibility of body damage but may reduce its likelihood or severity.
- We will be stopping on the trail for lunch so bring a chair, water and your lunch.

Special note: This is a **Jeep Badge of Honor Trail**. For those that would like to collect a badge after completing the trail, be sure to download the “Jeep Badge of Honor” app from your favorite app store prior to heading to the trail.
