- Adopt A Trail (AAT), Rob participated in a conference call about the new requirements for the US Forest Service (USFS) to keep return of the program moving forward. Katy volunteered to participate in the monthly conference call. We will be running Dishpan Springs August 27 to make a list of items needing to be addressed for USFS approval. Rob has secured two easy trails (Polique Canyon-2N09 and Gold Fever-3N05) to be adopted by Dirt Devils with a first checkout run scheduled for September 17.
