

Run Report
Saddleback Mountain Night Run
October 30, 2021

A total of 18 vehicles left as scheduled 5:30pm under fairly clear skies from the Chevron in Orange. 8 member rigs, 10 guests. Rob G trail lead, Dave/Trish as tail.

We arrived at the trailhead approximately 6:00 and proceeded to air down the rigs, departing about 15 mins later.
